TOWN OF WEBB LAKE

Burnett County, Wisconsin Board Meeting – August 5, 2019, 6:00 PM Webb Lake Town Hall

The regular monthly board meeting was called to order by Chairperson Steve Austin, at 6:00 PM at the Webb Lake Town Hall.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Roll call: Chairperson Steve Austin, Supervisor Greg Main, Supervisor John Kielkucki, Treasurer Wendy Purcell and Clerk Ken Busby were in attendance.

VERIFICATION OF PUBLIC POSTINGS: Busby stated the agenda was posted August 2, 2019 in three places and the town website.

CHANGES TO ORDER OF AGENDA: There were no changes made to the order of the agenda.

CORRESPONDENCE: No correspondance was commented on.

TOWNS ASSOCIATION/AMBULANCE REPORT: Main reported that he attended the Town's Association Meeting in July. In the second quarter, there were 6 – 911 calls in Webb Lake with an average response time of !5 minutes, 50 seconds. The Town of Scott is down to 10 minutes. Also talked about grants coming up in October. Still have a grant outstanding from 2 years ago. New grant needs to be approved prior to bids being sent out. Silent Springs might be a good candidate. The ratio of grant funds to town funding could be changing. State funding per mile of road is going up by \$426 per mile.

APPROVAL OF JULY MONTHLY MEETING MINUTES: Motion (Main/Kielkucki) to approve the minutes for the month of July. Motion carried 3-0

APPROVAL OF CLERK'S BILL LISTING: No questions. Motion (Kielkucki/Main) to approve the vouchers. Motion carried 3-0.

APPROVAL OF TREASURER'S REPORT: Purcell present the Treasurer's Report. Motion (Kielkucki/Main) to accept the Treasurer's report. Motion carried 3-0.

PUBLIC COMMENTS: Chris Kresl addressed about Saginaw road letter sent to him. He claims the road is his property. Kresl claimed the damage he has done is nothing worse than what nature has done with washouts occurring after a rain. Main responded that if the road is open to the public for 10 years, including maintenance, it is a town road. It is the property owner's responsibilty to prove it is not a town road and that will be very difficult to do. Kresl doesn't understand why the town wants the road to be a town road. There was a question from an unnamed attendee about the grant and what kind of projects it can include. Main responded that it needs to be a "permanent project". Can be paving or crack sealing. Needs to be a road project. Painting a center line is not considered a 10 year durable project and not allowed.

ADJOURNMENT: Motion to adjourn (Kielkucki/Main). Motion carried 3-0. Meeting adjourned at 6:19.
