## **RECYCLE GUIDE**

### Plastic #1 & 2

Rinse and remove caps

### Acceptable together:

Tin Cans, Plastic, Glass, Newspaper, Magazines

### Separate:

Aluminum cans

### Glass

(Bottles and jars only; clear, brown, green) Rinse and remove caps (labels are ok), avoid breaking. NO window glass, ceramics, china, light bulbs, mirror, or glass cookware!

### Acceptable

Newspapers & Magazines (inserts, catalogs, glossy flyers & paper) Corrugated cardboard (Paper bags, cereal & cake boxes, manilla envelopes, file folders) Office paper (white/pastel paper & envelopes, scratch paper, computer paper, label sheets, paper ream covers and post-it notes) Please put office paper in brown paper bags and tape shut. Phone books and all mail (remove plastic credit cards)

### Not Acceptable

Hard cover books. Carbon paper, food wrappers, tissue paper, paper towels, detergent boxes, waxed milk or juice cartons, produce boxes, wrapping paper. Styrofoam egg cartons and green house boxes, cool whip tubs, ice cream pails, toys, plastic film deli containers, plastic bags, food, Styrofoam, 5 gallon pails, caps, lids, vinyl siding or any other plastics that are not marked #1 & #2.
